Chattanooga, TN – Memorial Hospital's Mobile Mammogram Coach will provide mammogram screenings for women with or without insurance at the Rhea County Health Department on Thursday, Dec. 29.

The Mobile Health Coach will be at Rhea County Health Department, 344 Eagle Lane, Evansville, Tenn., from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. Eastern time.

Ladies age 40 and over who have not had a mammogram in the last 12 months are eligible **with or without insurance** by calling **Memorial Hospital's MaryEllen Locher Breast Center at 423-495-4040 or toll free 866-591-2254.**

Ladies will need to know their doctor's name, and those with insurance will need to bring their insurance cards and a photo ID.

All women should have one screening mammogram between the ages of 35 and 40. After age 40, a screening mammogram is recommended every year.

If you meet these age guidelines and have not had a mammogram in the last 12 months, you may participate, with or without insurance.

- If you have any breast abnormalities, even a small change or concern, call your doctor, who may order a diagnostic mammogram. We only do screening mammograms on the mobile unit.
- For those with insurance, we will file your insurance for you, but you must furnish your insurance card and a photo ID such as your driver's license.
- You need to know your doctor's first and last name. We must have a doctor's name to send your report.
