The Chattanooga Heart Institute Expands Services at Memorial

Chattanooga, TN –The Chattanooga Heart Institute is expanding services at its Chattanooga main campus next to Memorial Hospital to meet the growing needs of its patients.

As part of the integration between Memorial Health Care System and The Chattanooga Heart Institute, services were expanded at the Hixson office earlier this year. The office located in Erlanger Plaza on 3rd Street will move to the main CHI campus beginning Nov. 11.

“Relocating this office allows us to concentrate all of our efforts into expanding the outstanding cardiac program at Memorial,” said Paul Farmer, president of The Chattanooga Heart Institute. “Earlier this year, two of our cardiologists relocated from our office on 3rd Street, to our Hixson and main offices.”

James Hoback, M.D., the remaining cardiologist at the 3rd Street office, will relocate to The Chattanooga Heart Institute’s main campus.

“We look forward to Dr. Hoback joining his colleagues on our main campus and contributing to the growth of the excellent cardiac program at Memorial,” Mr. Farmer said. “The Chattanooga Heart Institute’s hospital services in Chattanooga will be provided at Memorial Hospital and Memorial Hospital Hixson.”
